Massachusetts licenses and IDs are issued by the Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV).

MASSACHUSETTS DRIVER'S LICENSE

To get a **learner's permit** and **driver's license**, you will need the following documents:

✓ Proof of identity & date of birth

- Passport
- F-1 visa (*valid OR expired for less than 36 months*)
- Form I-94 (*download from the CBP website*)

✓ Proof of Massachusetts residency

- Lease
- Utility bill
- Bank statement

✓ Proof of Social Security

- Social Security card
OR
- SSN Denial Letter
OR
- RMV Affidavit of No SSN

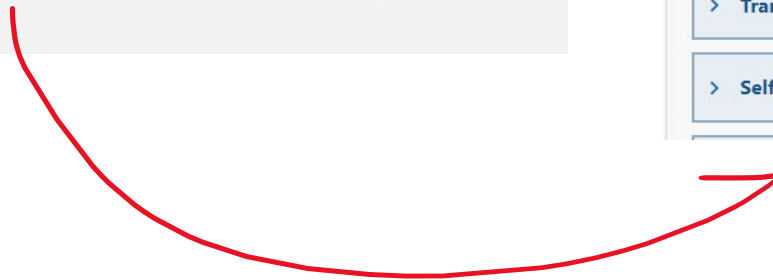

STEPS TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE

1. Apply for a learner's permit on the mass.gov/myRMV website
2. You will be notified via text and/or email when an in-person appointment is available at an RMV Service Center
3. Book an available appointment
4. Gather the required documents
5. Visit the Service Center on your appointment day, take the exam, get your learner's permit
6. Schedule your road test
7. Take the road test and get your driver's license

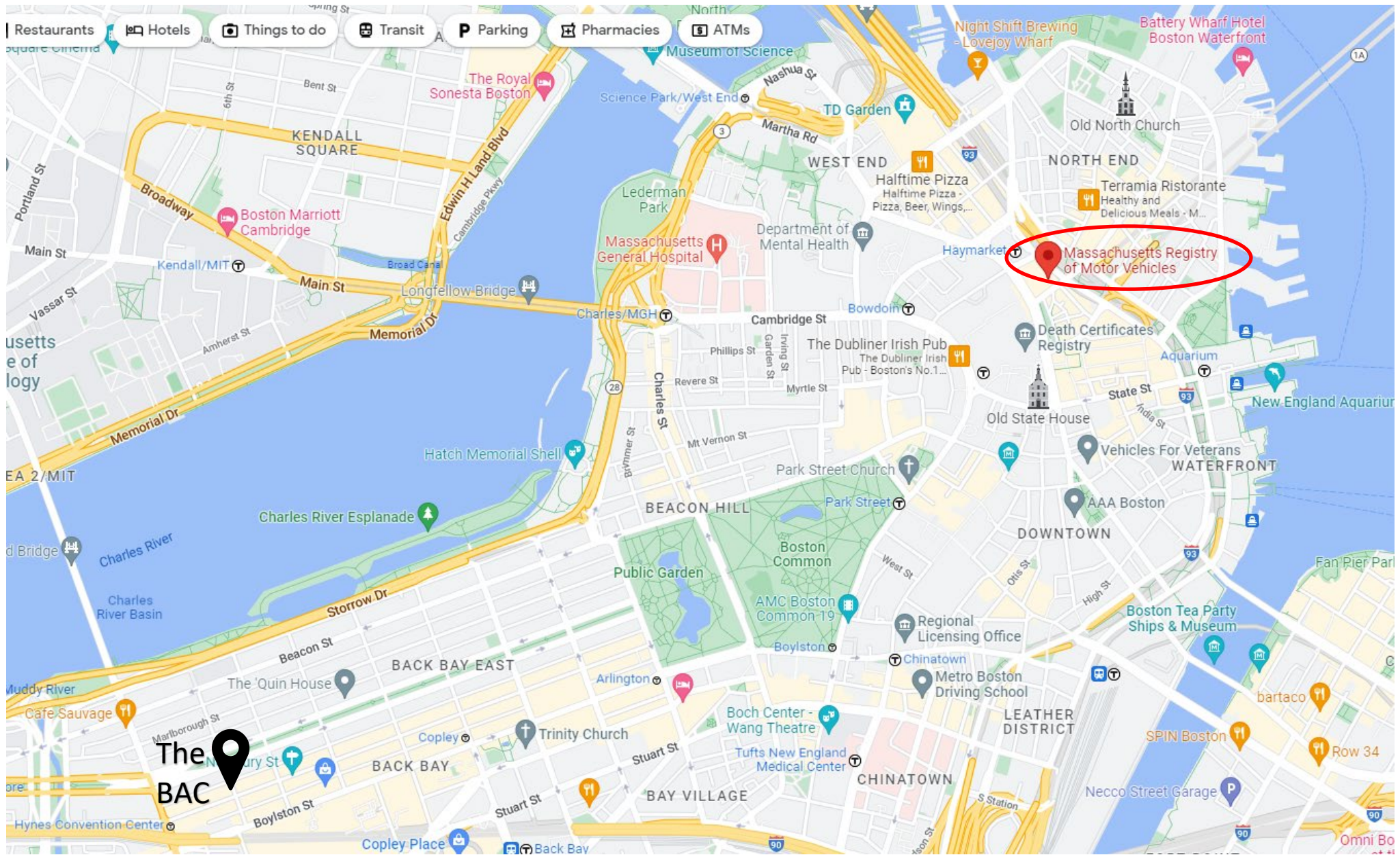
RMV FEES

Learner's Permit fee: **\$35**

Road Test fee: **\$35**

License fee: **\$50**

Fees can be paid in advance online. Only pay your fees to the Massachusetts RMV. Do not pay anyone else for RMV services.

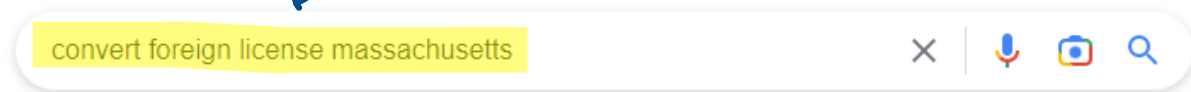


FOREIGN DRIVER'S LICENSE

The following countries can convert licenses to a Massachusetts driver's license:
Canada, Mexico, South Korea, Germany, France, Taiwan

Under certain circumstances, you may be able to use your foreign driver's license to drive in Massachusetts.

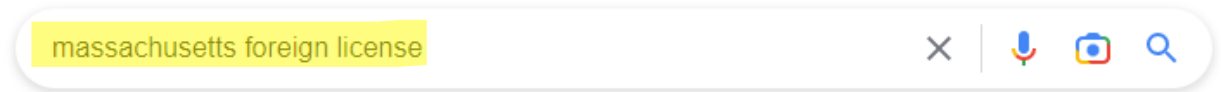

Driving in Massachusetts on a Foreign Driver's License

Foreign licensed drivers from any country, that meet certain requirements, may operate a motor vehicle in **Massachusetts**.

MASSACHUSETTS ID

To get a **Mass ID**, you will need the following documents:

✓ Proof of identity & date of birth

- Passport
- F-1 visa (*valid OR expired for less than 36 months*)
- Form I-20
- Form I-94 (*download from the CBP website*)

✓ Proof of Massachusetts residency

- Lease
- Utility bill
- Bank statement

✓ Proof of Social Security

- Social Security card
- OR
- SSN Denial Letter

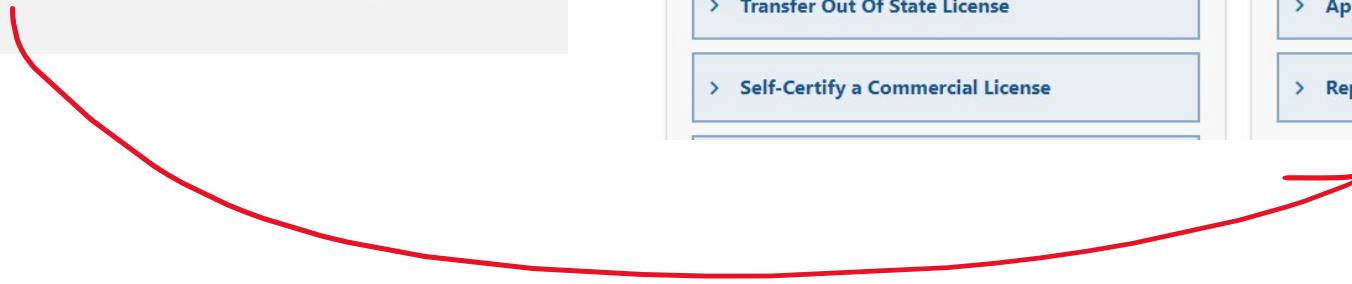

STEPS TO APPLY FOR A MASS ID

1. Apply for a Mass ID on the mass.gov/myRMV website
2. Book an available RMV Service Center appointment
3. Gather the required documents
4. Bring your completed application and required documents to the Service Center on your appointment day
5. Pay the **\$25** fee
6. Receive your Mass ID in the mail within 7-10 days

WHAT IS “REAL ID”

REAL ID is a form of Federal ID. When applying for your Mass ID or driver's license, you can choose if you want a REAL ID or not.



An application for REAL ID requires two documents to prove your MA residence. REAL ID cannot be renewed online while standard ID can.
