

INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACT

An Independent Study provides an educational opportunity for BAC students to create a course not already offered at the BAC, or participate in a pre-existing course, studying with an instructor on a one-on-one basis. Independent studies may be taken for 1.5 or 3.0 credits and will be based on the current tuition and fee schedule. In order to gain approval for an Independent Study, the following requirements must be met:

- For the creation of new courses, a student must submit, along with this form, a 1-3 page typed description of the proposed course, including a schedule of meetings with the instructor, assignments to be submitted, and the description of the final project and a resume from the instructor if s/he is not a BAC Faculty Member.

- All materials must be submitted to the Registrar's Office by the end of the Add period for which the Independent Study will take place
