The MLA program received its initial accreditation in the Fall of 2013 by the Landscape Architecture Accrediting Board (LAAB). The most recent accreditation visit by LAAB occurred in the Fall of 2016, where the program received a full 6-year accreditation. The next accreditation visit by LAAB is scheduled for the Fall of 2022.

The Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (BLA) program is a 1st professional degree awarded by the Boston Architectural College's School of Landscape Architecture. The BLA program is accredited by the Landscape Architecture Accrediting Board (LAAB). The most recent accreditation visit by LAAB occurred in the Fall of 2013, where the program received a full 6-year accreditation. The next accreditation visit by LAAB is scheduled for the Fall of 2019.

GRADUATION & RETENTION RATES

Of the 32 students that were enrolled in Fall 2016, 12% graduated in the 2016-2017 academic year. Of the remaining students, 97% returned in Fall 2017.

Of the graduating students, 25% graduated in 3 years, 25% graduated in 3.5 years, and 50% graduated in 4 years.

Of the 35 students currently enrolled in the 2017-2018 academic year, 9% are new students.

Of the 14 students that were enrolled in Fall 2016, 14% graduated in the 2016-2017 academic year. Of the remaining students, 100% returned in Fall 2017.

Of the graduating students, 50% graduated in 5 years and 50% graduated in 7.5 years.

Of the 16 students currently enrolled in the 2017-2018 academic year, 19% are new students.
