The MLA program received its initial accreditation in the Fall of 2013 by the Landscape Architecture Accrediting Board (LAAB). The most recent accreditation visit by LAAB occurred in the Fall of 2016, where the program received a full 6-year accreditation. The next accreditation visit by LAAB is scheduled for the Fall of 2022.

The Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (BLA) program is a 1st professional degree awarded by the Boston Architectural College's School of Landscape Architecture. The BLA program is accredited by the Landscape Architecture Accrediting Board (LAAB). The most recent accreditation visit by LAAB occurred in the Fall of 2013, where the program received a full 6-year accreditation. GRADUATION & RETENTION RATES

Of the 37 students enrolled in Fall 2015, 24% (9 students) of MLA students graduated in the 2015-2016 academic year while 70% of students returned Fall 2016.

Of those 9 students, 50% graduated in 3 years, 37.5% graduated in 2.5 years, and 12.5% graduated in 3.5 years.

Of the 34 students currently enrolled in the 2016-2017 academic year, 23.5% are new students.

BLA

Of the 16 students enrolled in the Fall of 2015, 18.75% (3 students) of BLA students graduated in the 2015-2016 academic year while 68.75% of students returned in Fall 2016.

Of those 3 students, 66% graduated in 4.5 years.

Of the 12 students currently enrolled in the 2016-2017 academic year, 8% are new students.
