

CITIZENSHIP DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Our records indicate that further information is needed regarding your Citizenship status. Please present a copy of *one* of the documents below to our office. If you are unable to come into our office, please complete the Citizenship Affidavit document included with this form. If you are an:

U.S. Citizen or U.S. National - please submit a copy of a valid U.S. Passport, Birth Certificate or Naturalization Certificate

Eligible non-citizen - please submit a copy of *one* of the following documents:

U.S. Permanent Resident with an Alien Registration Receipt Card - ARC I-151 OR I-551

Conditional Permanent Resident - ARC I-551C

Other Eligible non-citizen with an Arrival Departure Record - I-94 from the Department of Homeland Security showing any of the following designations.

- Refugee
- Asylum Granted
- Indefinite Parole and/or Humanitarian Parole
- Cuban-Haitian Entrant

Victim of Human Trafficking – T-Visa holder – T-1, T-2, T-3 etc.

If you are an eligible non-citizen and FAFSA is unable to verify your eligibility a verification process will be performed with the Department of Homeland Security which may take about 3 weeks.

➤ If you have only a Notice of Approval to Apply for Permanent Residence (I-171 or I-464), if you are in the U.S. on an F1 or F2 student visa, B1, B2 Visitor Visa, J1, J2 exchange visa, or G, H, L series visa you are not eligible for federal student.
