TUITION AND FEES

Tuition charges are based on your registration. We encourage you to review the listing of 2017-2018 [tuition and fees](#), along with [refund policies](#), prior to registration. Included in your fees will be a non-refundable Registration Fee.

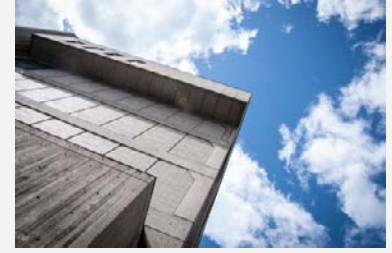
Bills for tuition will be available on May 15. An email notification will be sent alerting you that your bill is available in Self-Service. Paper statements will also be post-mailed to your current address. Payment will be due by June 15. For more information regarding [payment options](#) and [late payments](#), please visit our website.

Registrations not completed online by May 5, will need to be submitted manually to the Registrar's Office and will be subject to a Late Registration Fee of \$100. Registrations received after May 14 will be billed within 1-2 business days and payment will still be due June 15. After June 15 payment will be due at the time of registration.

FINANCIAL AID

Students receiving financial aid must have their financial aid fully approved prior to the billing deadline. Fully approved financial aid will appear as Anticipated Aid on your student account. If you have not already done so, you may still apply for financial aid by completing a [FAFSA](#) for the 2017-2018 academic year.

Students in the Master of Design Studies Program receiving federal financial aid must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 academic credits that apply towards their degree requirements in semesters where they are receiving federal aid. Failure to enroll in the minimum required credits will result in the cancellation of federal aid. Failure to attend or complete courses in which you are enrolled may result in the reduction or cancellation of your federal aid. Graduate students are awarded Direct Federal Loans to cover their tuition and anticipated fees. Students may be able to borrow additional funds for any direct costs or education related expenses, such as Intensive Week costs.

TUITION REFUND INSURANCE
