Dear BAC Community,

Starting March 10, the BAC has updated its campus mask mandates to reflect the following:

- Community members who have met BAC vaccination requirements: masks are optional but strongly encouraged.
- Community members who are unvaccinated and have waived the BAC vaccination requirements: surgical grade masks are still required to be worn correctly.
- Visitors who show proof of vaccination: masks are optional but strongly encouraged.
- Visitors who do not show proof of vaccination: surgical grade masks are still required to be worn correctly.

In addition to these mask updates, the BAC will allow food to be consumed on campus for both personal and social purposes.

The BAC will continue with its existing vaccination and booster requirements along with existing COVID-19 surveillance testing protocol requirements.
